

DIOCESAN ABUSE PREVENTION AND SAFE ENVIRONMENT WORKSHOPS OFFERED

Any adult (18 and over, paid or volunteer) responsible for the instruction and guidance of children and young people including Catholic school teachers and aides, parish catechetical leaders, catechists, youth ministers and youth advisors and coaches must complete:

- o Fingerprinting
- o Criminal Background Check
- o **Diocesan Abuse Prevention Workshop**
- o **Safe Environment Teaching Prevention Workshop**
- o Read Diocesan Code of Conduct for Church Personnel and Volunteers and sign the required form
- o Read Policy and Procedural Guidelines Relating to Sexual Abuse by Church Personnel and Volunteers and sign the required form
- o All Catholic school teachers must also complete the "Lures" Program
