What is Camp Out?

Because of the geographic constraints of the diocese, our young people rarely meet other Catholic youth outside of their deaneries. The structure and atmosphere of Camp Out creates an environment where they can connect and interact with youth from other parishes in a caring and Christian environment.

When is the registration deadline? **March 19, 2010**

A packet will be mailed to youth ministers by February 24th. The registration deadline is March 19, 2010 or when the Christ Our Redeemer has received paperwork and fees for 250 participants. Who can participate in Camp Out?

The annual Camp Out is open to all parish **high school** youth groups and Scout troops. Each group should have their own guidelines as to who is eligible for participation.

At the Camp Out, parishes need one adult female for every six female youth and one adult male for every six male youth. If you have a small group and need to join another group for chaperone purposes contact Sue Marco ASAP.

Typical Campout Schedule

FRIDAY

- Parishes arrive at Timpooshee from 4:00–7:00 p.m. and bring their own dinner. No cooking allowed at campsites.
- Reconciliation Service with Adoration
- Parishes gather at camp sites to pray and prepare for bed

SATURDAY

- Morning Prayer
- Prepare Creative Presentations – groups are formed with members of different parishes
- Creative Presentations
- Volleyball Tournament – These teams are the same groups that prepared creative presentations.
- Dinner
- Saturday Evening - Dance, board games, campfire, hang out with your new friends
- Parishes gather at camp sites to pray and prepare for bed
- Lights out – Quiet / Sleep Time
